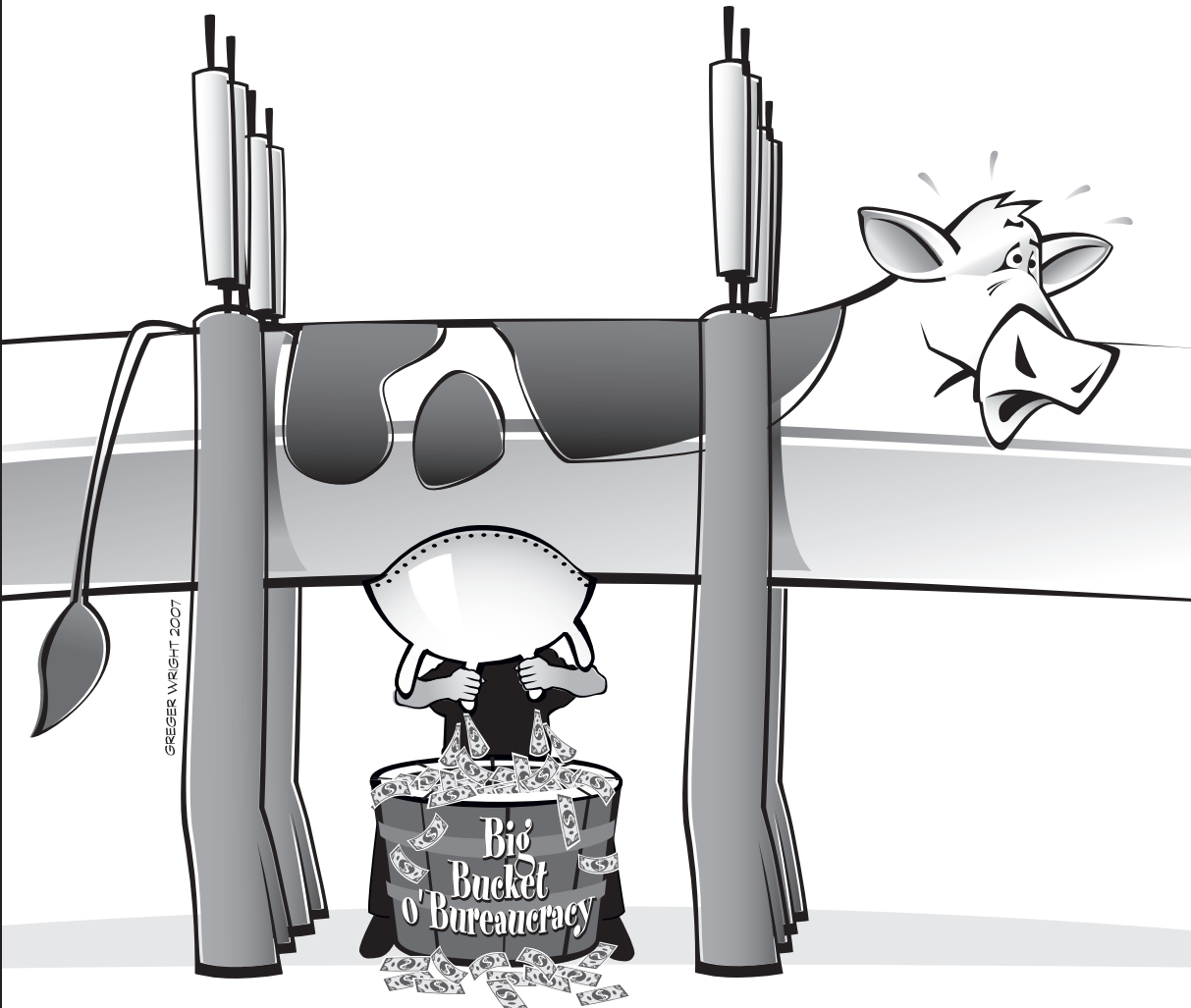


Got Milked?



Squeezing more government out of declining oil production

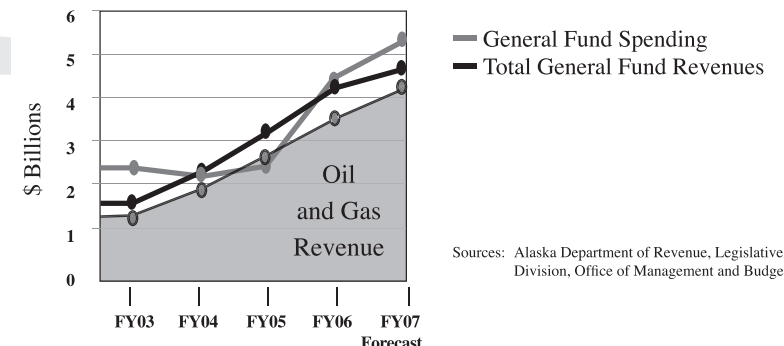
